

## FIELD GUIDE COURSE – PACKLIST

*Please note that a lot of these items can be purchased in the town close by*

- Appropriate items for Summer conditions (t-shirts, sandals, raincoat, shorts)
- Appropriate items for Winter conditions (warm items, warm jacket, gloves, beanie)
- Neutral coloured clothing for game drives/walks (khaki, brown, grey, beige, green)
- Comfortable hiking boots (ideally waterproof or another pair for a rainy season)
- Cap or hat
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen
- Binoculars (A decent pair is highly recommended – 8 x 32 to 10 x 42)
- Torch and/or headlamp
- Lip-ice/moisturiser/insect repellent
- Backpack (daypack)
- Water bottle (ideally a 2L camelback or water bladder which fits into a daypack)
- Normal belt (to attach to ammunition pouch)
- Fully sealed box for snacks (for inside your tent, otherwise animals could be attracted)
- Sleeping bag/sleeping mat (for sleepouts and winter conditions, we provide summer duvet, linen and a pillow)
- Warm water bottle for winter (flask)
- Camera/video camera/laptop (recommended, not compulsory)
- Adapters, chargers, spare batteries (torch, camera, cell phone)
- Stationery (A4 pads, small notepad, pens)
- Towels
- Toiletries
- Snacks
- Cigarettes
- Personal medication
- Pocket money (next ATM is location in Thabazimbi – 30 minutes away)
- Personal medical-aid
- Insurance for personal liability (student-to-student)

*Safe parking available in case you bring your own vehicle. You're welcome to bring leisure items (i.e. frisbee, juggling balls, etc.). Camp-safe for small valuables available.*

**In order to register for the course you will need:**

Medical-aid, driver's license, 2 x passport photos, 2 x copies of passport/ driver's license/ PrDP, copy of highest qualification.
